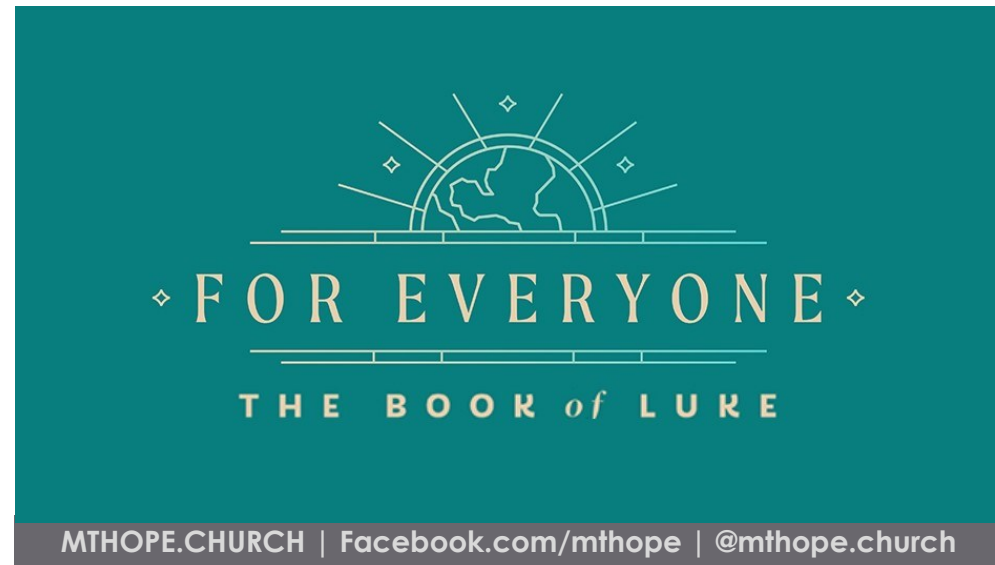

High School Retreat

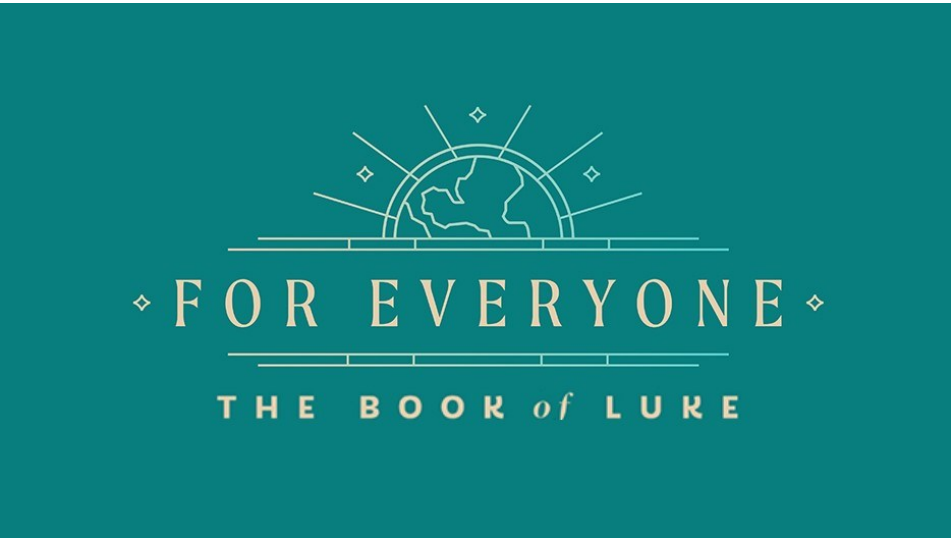
